E pule kākou- Let's pray

E pule kākou i ka pule _____. Mākaukau? **A pule-** Let's pray the _____ prayer. Ready? And pray

E mele kākou i ke mele _____. Mākaukau? **A 'oia.-** Let's sing the _____ song. Ready? And begin.

E pelu ka wāwae, nānā ka maka, ho'olohe ka pepeiao, pa'a ka waha, pa'a ka lima, ma ka 'uhā- Fold your legs, look with your eyes, listen with your ears, keep your mouth quiet, fold your hands in your lap.

E hapai ka lima- Raise your hand
