E hāleu- wipe

Pepe hāleu- toilet paper

E komo i ka lole- put on clothes

Pale ma'i- underwear

Lole wāwae- shorts/pants

Pale 'ili/pālule- shirt/top/blouse

Mu'u- dress

Wā hiamoe- nap time

Pela moe- sleep mat

Hāli'i- sheet

Kapa- blanket

Uluna- pillow

E hiamoe- go to sleep

E pani i kou maka- close your eyes

E ala mai- wake up
